Did You Work as a Volunteer Coach in an NCAA Division I Athletics Program in a Sport Other Than Baseball?

You Could Get Money from a \$303 Million Settlement.

There is a \$303 million proposed settlement with National Collegiate Athletic Association (“NCAA”) in a class action lawsuit that claims NCAA Bylaws that prohibited schools from paying wages, salaries, or benefits to Division I coaches who were designated as “volunteer coaches” violated federal antitrust laws.

You could get money if you worked as a “volunteer coach” for any NCAA Division I sports program, other than baseball, any time between March 17, 2019 to June 30, 2023. File your claim by **June 2, 2026**. Valid claims get a minimum of \$5,000.
